Home reading book arrangements help me support my child's reading at home.	45	45	5	1	4	<p>What is going well</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In all but one statement for teaching, learning and assessment, 90% or more of people agreed or strongly agreed with the statement. The overall feeling was very positive. 66% of people strongly agreed that their child made good progress at Priory. People were positive that Priory learners were inspired to love learning and encouraged to be creative. It was clear that people feel that Priory offers a wide range of enrichment opportunities. <p>What we need to improve</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A focus on how homework currently looks at Priory is a development point. Ensure that parents/carers are supported and shown how they can help their child with their learning. Although parents/carers may not know how we meet additional needs if their child does not have needs it would be good to share the work we do in school to support additional needs.
