TRAINING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All staff have been trained by S Lee during a staff meeting on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2018 and the school will direct new staff and/or staff who couldn't attend Sarah's training to use the online Government updated training.</li><li>• Some staff who couldn't attend Sarah Lee's training have (some TAs, part-time teachers, MSAs and a Governors) completed the updated online Government PREVENT training and recognise risk factors and those vulnerable to extremism. Certificates printed for collection in the Office.</li><li>• Most staff are aware of how to make a referral, due to the Prevent training, but also to liaise with either the HT or any designated person in school for advice: <a href="mailto:prevent@nottinghamshire.pnn.police.uk">prevent@nottinghamshire.pnn.police.uk</a></li><li>• Staff are aware of and exemplify British Values in school through PRIDE lessons and assemblies.</li><li>• The Headteacher is the SCOP within school (single point of contact)</li></ul>	Green
SAFEGUARDING POLICY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Priory Junior adopts the Nottinghamshire County Council Child Protection Policy and uses KCSIE each year. This is approved by Governors and shared with all staff.</li><li>• A copy of the policy is available to parents and other stakeholders via the school website</li><li>• The updates in the policy re Prevent Duty were shared at a staff meeting with all staff (annually)</li></ul>	Green
E SAFETY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Online Safety is outline in the policy and also in the behaviour and anti-bullying policies.</li><li>• ICT equipment in school is subject to filters, led by Atom IT- these are in place and monitored. Any updates are applied when identified to prevent access to extremism material</li><li>• All equipment is supplied via Atom IT and are in line with regulations</li><li>• Children are taught to be safe online through the PSHE, SMSC curriculum, and themed weeks within school</li><li>• Teachers speak to the children regularly about staying safe online, concerns are then communicated to parents</li></ul>	Green
VISITORS POLICY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All visitors to the school must report to reception and are signed in and out electronically and issued with a badge.</li><li>• Any regular visitors to the school are subject to the DBS checks and information on this can be found in the school office; governed by Caroline Loom (SBM)</li></ul>	Green
