- 1) *To be or not to be, that is the question?*

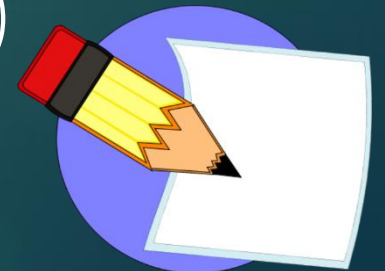
Trips linked to our topics...

English:

Reading, Writing and Spelling

- ▶ Reading at least 3 x a week EVERY week (**Diary check on Fridays!**)
- ▶ English lessons using engaging texts to hook the children e.g. digi-texts, Stormbreaker
- ▶ Children reading as a writer - reading question focus weekly.
- ▶ Writing
- ▶ GaPS (Grammar, punctuation and spelling)
- ▶ Handwriting and pen licences (Year 6).



Maths & Multiplication Superheroes

- ▶ Maths to be taught every day, in class groups.
- ▶ Maths lessons to have 'real' related elements to allow children to link maths to real life.
- ▶ **Multiplication Superheroes** – children will be tested by class teachers and work towards their superhero badges. Multiplication tables need to be learnt fluently both in school and at home. Children will have a booklet to work on in school and they will continue working from the badge they last received.
- ▶ Problem solving and investigations throughout topics focusing on a Mastery approach
- ▶ Arithmetic practise - quick fire questions daily.
- ▶ **Mymaths**- homework will be set on this, if unable to access then it is expected children talk to class teacher before homework hand in day.



MFL and Music

Both subjects to be taught fortnightly this year by Mrs Hill/Miss Edwards and Mrs Clark as well as class teachers.



Modern Foreign Languages

- ▶ Modern Foreign Language is French.
- ▶ Foundation for future language learning, complements English.
- ▶ Using a range of resources, both authentic and specially written for language students (Mr Men, Disney books, Simpsons comics) to stimulate reading and writing.
- ▶ Games and songs to be used for listening and speaking activities.
- ▶ Focus on “My World” – self, family, friends, school, hometown.
- ▶ Extra-curricular club to help build on language skills.

Music

- ▶ Engaging Music scheme- Charanga
- ▶ Building understanding of inter-related dimensions of music

Homework and Help at home

- ▶ Homework goes out weekly in children's home learning journals.
- ▶ There will be a maths piece each week (May be a online Mymaths piece)
- ▶ English (Grammar) homework will come home when needed.
- ▶ Practice times-tables as much as you can – this will really help your child in their maths.
- ▶ Ask the question every night... *What have you learned today?*
- ▶ Homework is expected to be in on time every week – it is expected as a basic of Priory Pride and is good experience for the move to Secondary School.



Diaries and reading planners...

- ▶ Please encourage your Child to read at least 3 times a week and record their progress in the new diaries.
Diaries will be checked on a Friday.
- ▶ Your diary can be used for communication between your child and their teacher.
- ▶ Diaries should be in school every day.



GUIDED READING

- Quality small group time with your child **every** week.
- Starts at 9:15 – 9:45 so please make sure your child is on time.



Uniform & PE kit



- ▶ PE kit is needed every day – Year 6 PE is Friday.
- ▶ Please encourage your child to bring the correct uniform in every day and PE kit (Priory Pride).
- ▶ Details of our school uniform can be found on our school website.

SATs

- All children have to be tested before they go to secondary school
- Provide assessment information for secondary schools
- ▶ SATs will take place from **Monday 14th May until Thursday 17th May 2018**
- ▶ All children need to be in school this week.

Format of the tests- AWL

- A reading test (1 hour)
- A grammar, punctuation and spelling test (45mins and 20 spellings)
- Maths
 - 30 minute Arithmetic test (approx 30 marks)
 - Two 45 minute written tests (Paper 1 and 2- no calculator paper)
- ▶ All evidence of children's writing throughout the year will be assessed by Priory staff and moderated by people from the LA.
